Sermon Title: **Encounters with Jesus -- Just a Crumb**

Scripture: **Matthew 15: 21-28**

Leaving that place, Jesus withdrew to the region of Tyre and Sidon. A Canaanite woman from that vicinity came to him, crying out, "Lord, Son of David, have mercy on me! My daughter is demon-possessed and suffering terribly." Jesus did not answer a word. So his disciples came to him and urged him, "Send her away, for she keeps crying out after us." He answered, "I was sent only to the lost sheep of Israel." The woman came and knelt before him. "Lord, help me!" she said. He replied, "It is not right to take the children's bread and toss it to the dogs." "Yes it is, Lord," she said. "Even the dogs eat the crumbs that fall from their master's table." Then Jesus said to her, "Woman, you have great faith! Your request is granted." And her daughter was healed at that moment.

Sermon Outline:

- I. A mother comes to Jesus for her child out of anguish and despair.
- II. The only answer to her child's pain is Jesus.
- III. She starts by acknowledging who He is and is clothed in humility.
- IV. There was a disdain between the Jewish people and the Canaanite (Gentile) people.
- V. Jesus's first response is silence.
- VI. Jesus than responds that she is not part of the mission He has been sent for. It is not her time yet.
- VII. Her response was to keep asking and to keep worshipping Him despite not hearing what she wanted.
- VIII. She never loses sight that Jesus is the answer. Her faith changes Jesus's mind, because she knew He was more than enough.
