Sermon Outline:

1. We long to see expressions of faithfulness. We were created for faithfulness.
2. Free people are bound to faithful love.
3. Sex is a powerful bond not simply a way of expressing love.
4. Sex and marriage bear witness to God.
5. Single life is to also point to God
6. Faithfulness is not just staying out of someone else's bed but loving the bed you are in.
7. We are not saved by our faithfulness but by God's faithfulness.

We face temptation when:

- We have not learned to work through differences.
- We have constructed an idealized vision of love and marriage.
- We have fallen into the trap of addictive and destructive habits.
