WHO WE ARE

Our mission as a church is to lead people to a deep, personal relationship with Jesus, and we do that with a unique flavor as expressed in our 5 Ms:

1. **Monastic:** Slowing down to be with God in the midst of a fast-paced and busy city. We draw deeply from the contemplative and monastic traditions.
2. **Multiracial:** Bridging racial, cultural, economic, and gender barriers. Over 73 nations are represented in our community.
3. **eMotional Health:** Experiencing transformation deep beneath the surface in order to love God, ourselves, and others well.
4. **Marriage to Christ:** Shaping our lives out of deep relationship with Jesus first, whether we are married or single.
5. **Missional:** Offering the gift of our true selves to the world.

We strive to create a culture on our staff team of fun, autonomy, and integrity, where people have the freedom to experiment, make mistakes, learn, and grow in both their inner life (soul - their journey with God) and their outer life (role - their skills and position in the organization).

YOUR ROLE AS TECHNICAL COORDINATOR

Do you value high-quality audio and video? Are you a technical guru that has experience in researching and improving Audio/Visual/Lighting (AVL) systems in organizations? Do you enjoy training others in these areas and galvanizing team spirit to tackle projects and see results? We are looking for someone who will take the lead in our AVL area and manage a dynamic group of volunteers for our Churchwide Services and events. The AVL area includes sound, video, projection, live stream and lighting. We need someone to give excellent leadership to an area that's growing at a fast pace as we strive to improve our AVL experience across the board.

Your role would be to:

1. Give leadership to the AVL area to bring high-quality, consistent sound and visuals to our church wide services and events.
2. Lead (recruit, train and equip) your team of volunteers in a way that fosters a spirit of excellence, commitment, community, and creativity. Schedule volunteers for Sundays and events.
3. Work to continually improve our AVL areas and be creative in implementing high-quality AVL in our context.

4. Work alongside the Worship Pastor to support the Worship Team to function effectively.
5. Manage live stream and work to improve our live stream experience on Sundays.
6. Maintain equipment, and work with the Worship Pastor to develop and update the related budget as needed, and make recommendations for purchasing and updating AVL equipment.

This role may be an especially good fit for you if you:

1. Are a technical person (sound engineer, videographer, or producer) with experience and technical training in this arena who enjoys a fast-paced, dynamic environment.
2. Understand the importance of high-quality AVL and its contribution to a successful event.
3. Value hands-on experience, troubleshooting, and creative problem-solving. We want someone who is willing to get their hands dirty and able to think outside the box given our limited space and resources.
4. Enjoy building and leading a group of volunteers.
5. Enjoy implementing technical systems and seeing the fruits of your labor.
6. Love our multicultural church environment and growing with a staff team.

Part-Time to Full-Time Position: This position will start as a contractual part-time position with potential for full-time after a probationary period. Required hours include Sundays (2 services) and Thursday night rehearsals, monthly staff meetings, and occasional church-wide events. Other hours are flexible. You report to the Pastor of Worship.

Compensation: Starting rate of \$25/hr.
